

The following trees and their cultivars shall not be planted on the public right-of-way, on public property within, or as part of required landscaping within the City Limits of Mount Vernon Iowa. Additionally, it is recommended that these trees are not planted on private property within the City. Trees with mature heights greater than or equal to 25' are restricted from being planted in locations under overhead utility lines. Trees will only be permitted to be planted in the Right-of-Way if the width of the parkway is 4' wide or greater. Trees are not recommended to be planted at spacings tighter than 40' on center between both existing and replacement trees. All trees planted within the Right-of-Way are subject to the review and approval of the City Administrator, Chris Nosbisch.
